Small Group Bible Study Questions

- A) This past weekend, we had the pleasure of hosting our Local Missionary Partners, Long Beach Rescue Mission (Rev. Bill Thomas, Pastor/CEO), and Child Evangelism Fellowship (Claudia Arellanes, Missionary Director). Take a few minutes to re-cap, in your groups, the top impressions you have after hearing about these groups and their missions to reach people in the name of Jesus Christ.
- B) Both Bill and Claudia shared specific prayer requests with us to lift up to the Lord on the behalf of each of their respective organizations. Take some time with your group to pray for the Long Beach Rescue Mission (and Rev. Thomas) and Child Evangelism Fellowship (and Claudia Arellanes).
- C) One of the goals of our time with each of these local partners, is to mobilize our own congregation to get involved -- personally -- in the mission of each of these organizations. Discuss in your small group how your family, small group, or you individually can get involved in the ministry of our Local Missionary Partners.
- D) Of course, in the midst of speaking about missionaries and reaching the lost, we should not lose sight of who God is placing in the our own paths who need to hear about the Great News of Jesus Christ. Take some time in your group to share at least one name with your group who you would like to pray for that you sense God is calling on you to speak with about the Gospel. Sharing your faith can be scary stuff! Let's not depend on ourselves to make it happen, let's commit, in prayer, that God will make it happen and pray He will use us in the process. Make sure each of you note who you are praying for, and keep one another accountable to sharing the "next step" with your "one" in the weeks which are coming up in our Missions Conference!
