1) New Year's Resolutions

- A) The top ten New Year's resolutions for 2007 (according to CNN) are:
 - 1) Lose some weight and get into better shape!
 - 2) Get out of debt and/or increase income!
 - 3) Get a better job (measured by task and income)!
 - 4) Give up a habit/addiction (stop smoking, drinking)!
 - 5) Improve education/go back to school!

- 6) Purchase a home or change/improve housing!
- 7) Find a mate/get a date/get a second date!
- 8) Be more organized/manage time better!
- 9) Be a better spouse/parent/family member!
- 10) Travel to a special destination/recreation & leisure!
- B) The Bible tells us that having a vision for the future is a good thing (Proverbs 29:18). New Year's resolutions (or any kind of resolution) are great for providing vision, as long as the vision is provided by God...
- C) The Bible teaches us that when we choose to do things our own way, we are like poor and foolish people who seem like we are following God, but are not (Jeremiah 5:2-4).
- D) The Bible calls this type of living "worldly wisdom" (James 3:13-16). Worldly wisdom appears to be "good," but proves to be without God's direction, which leads to destruction.
- E) Rather, the Bible says that all of our "resolutions" need to be submitted to "God's will" (James 4:13-17). The Bible calls on us to constantly improve our character and actions, but to do so "without arrogance, in the Lord."

2) How Can I Know God's Will For My Life?

A) If our resolutions need to be submitted to "God's will," how do we discover God's will for our lives? Can we know God's will? Is it possible to have resolutions which are in line with the will of God? **YES!!**

- B) Despite popular opinion, God's will is not hidden from His people. God has made His will abundantly clear in Scripture (Romans 12:1-2).
- C) Historically, the writers and people of God did not "walk around in the dark," confused as to the will of God:
 - 1) Paul was an apostle by the will of God (Ephesians 1:1).
 - 2) We find security in the will of God (Colossians 4:12).
 - 3) The will of God is common knowledge and practice for all Christians (1st Thessalonians 4:3)
 - 4) The will of God is so clear in Scripture, it is viewed as the polar opposite of mankind's unstable and unpredictable ways (1st Peter 2:15, 4:1-6).

3) The One Great Source For Knowing God's Will

- A) God has made His will clearly known through the written Word of God, the Bible, the Scriptures (2nd Timothy 3:16-17). We are called to know God's word and handle it well (2nd Timothy 2:15).
- B) We know for sure that it is God's will for us to be sanctified (1st Thessalonians 4:3). God's word is what sanctifies the Christian (John 17:17).
- C) As we contemplate resolutions for the New Year, will you make it your top priority to submit your resolutions to God's will? His will is not hidden from you, but is clear and evident on the pages of Scripture. Will you make it your personal resolution to "increase in knowing and doing God's will" in the upcoming year?!
