~2nd Corinthians 3:18 (ESV)

1) A Jesus Story Reflecting God's Unseen Glory

- A) Like today, recommendation letters (2nd Corinthians 3:1-6) in the ancient world were 3rd party testimonies of personal relationship which affirmed character and expertise.
- B) Incredibly, the testimony of Jesus Christ is authenticated by the Spirit-written lives of God's people, rather than on the pages of books (cf. Psalm 37:30-31).
- C) The ministry of God's Spirit (indwelling the hearts of His people) is more glorious than even the Old Testament Law, and reflects God's glory with greater brilliance (3:8, 16-18).
- D) WE are entrusted with this great ministry of "reflecting" (4:1, 5-6)! We reflect Jesus (cf. Colossians 1:28-29)! It is His light and His life which we reflect, God's great glory!
- E) With a selfless "jars of clay" heart (4:7-12) we reflect the brilliant grace and hope of the Gospel of Jesus (4:13-16).
- F) Living in authentic relationship with Jesus (communion) "cleans" our reflectiveness, and heals a blind world (4:18)!
