I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.

1) God Fills With Benefit

- A) The Bible has various ways it uses the word "bless," "blessing" and "blessed." But, each variation is connected to a simple core meaning in the Bible. "To bless" is "to fill someone or something with benefit, almost always for the purpose of blessing others."
- B) God is the source of blessing in the Bible. For example, God blesses the creation – creatures (Genesis 1:22), mankind (1:28), and the Sabbath (2:3)
- C) Importantly, God is the source of blessing for mankind
 Adam & Eve (1:28, 5:2), Noah and his family (9:1), and significantly, Abraham and his family (12:2-3).
- D) When God blesses someone/something, the outcome is guaranteed. In other words, God's blessings are promises providing a foundation for human purpose, and God always provides for His purposes.

2) Blessing Flows From Blessing

A) Just as God "created" and "blessed," so also God "recreates" and "blesses" (Ephesians 1:3-4). Without a relationship with Jesus Christ, we cannot experience true blessing (2:8-9), our authentic purpose (2:10).

(Genesis 12:2-3)





- B) It is easy to get overwhelmed with wickedness in our world. Some new bit of horrible news seems to pour in through our phones, TV's, and tablets every day.
- C) Like our culture, we can habitually look for the next "bad thing" in our lives, allowing negativity drive our days and weeks. Without noticing, our busy lives, disappointing jobs, frustrating families, painful losses, etc., become the fuel of comments and conversations.
- D) Even positive inputs, such as social media, can be disillusioning. We scroll through "friends," we witness their delightful selfies, the otherworldly photos of loving and perfect families, and we wonder why our own lives are so boring and unphotogenic.
- E) With so many minute-by-minute inputs for our souls, God's blessings are easily obscured. When we are disconnected from God's blessings, we lose purpose, and we lose our voice to bless others.
- F) God calls YOU with the promise of great purpose and great blessing (1 Peter 2:9-10). As we are blessed by Jesus, we "follow his steps" and bless others (2:21-25).

3) For The Purpose of Blessing Others

- A) God's blessings are never meant "just for us," they are always to be shared with others (Ephesians 4:29, 32).
- B) How do we do it? By understanding God's blessings from Scripture, we are given a "shaping" or "form" of how we are to bless others (see sidebar).
- C) God's blessings come to life as they unite together in relationships, providing a context for speaking God's truth into one another's lives (Colossians 3:12-17).
- D) This is "verbal grace-giving," the "divine vision casting" of giving away what the Spirit of God reveals to you on behalf of others (Ephesians 4:29).
