In-Depth

• Before we look at today's Bible passage, let's discuss the nature of the Gospels. In what ways are the gospels similar to and different from other types (genres) of literature (e.g. historical narrative, biography, epistles, etc.)?

Read Luke 1:26-38

Discuss the characters and events with your group

- 1. Read the following prophecies and note how they apply to today's lesson:
 - A. 2 Samuel 7:12-17
 - B. Isaiah 7:14
 - C. Isaiah 9:1-7
- 2. What can we discern about Mary from this passage?

How would you contrast Mary's response with that of Zechariah to similar news?

Making It Relevant

1. God's plan for a savior/Messiah was announced many hundreds of years before Jesus was born. How does that truth impact your love for God?

Your relationship with Jesus?

How you share Jesus with others?

2. Mary's understanding of God's plan for her was limited, but she had faith and trusted in God (v38). Are there areas in your life where the same faith principle could apply?
