

I. Observe His delay in responding, John 2:1-3

- A. Jesus displays apparent indifference, John 2:4
- B. Jesus maintains the priority of discipleship, John 2:4. Note Jesus' priorities in His interactions with His family, Luke 2:41-50; Mark 3:21, 31; John 7:2-10
- C. Jesus calls for persistence and confidence, John 2:5. See also **Bonus Section #1.**
- **II.** Consider His disregard for tradition, *John 2:6*; compare 2:13-16, 19; 3:1-5; 4:12-14, 20-24; 5:16-18, and so on. See also Luke 5:36-39; John 1:17

III. Be in awe of His display of glory, John 2:7-11

- A. The miracle is a "sign," proving that He is THE Son of God. See Bonus Section #2.
- B. The miracle manifested His glory, John 2:11.
- C. The miracle shows His power (over nature).
- D. The miracle shows His sensitivity (by its directness).
- E. The miracle shows His character, John 1:17.
- F. The miracle shows the luxury of His grace. See also John 6:10-11.
- G. The miracle shows the quality of His grace, John 2:10.
- H. The miracle shows the abundance of His grace, John 2:6. See also John 6:12-13.

What is this miracle telling us? John 3:34; 1:16; Ephesians 1:6-8, 18-19; 2:7; 3:19, 20; 5:18; John 15:11; 16:24; 17:13. See also **Bonus Section #3**.

BONUS SECTION #4: Themes in the Gospel of John

- 1. Jesus as the Son of God (also called "the Son"). Along with this goes the unique relationship that the Son has with the Father.
- 2. Jesus as the Messiah, the Christ Jesus as King: 6:15; 12:12-19; 18:33-37; 19:3, 12-15, 19, 20
- 3. Jesus as the fulfillment of the Old Testament: 3:3-10, 14-15; 5:39, 45-46; 8:56; 12:14, 38-39, 41; 19:36. The Passover and Feast of Tabernacles also find their fulfillment in Jesus. This is related to the next item . . .
- 4. Jesus "replacing" Jewish customs, including Jewish ritual purification (2:6-9); Jewish Temple (2:16); Jewish worship in Jerusalem (4:21-24); Jewish manna (6:31-51); Jewish shepherds (Chapter 10); Jewish leaders and teachers.
- 5. Jesus as "sent" by the Father. Very prominent.
- 6. The deity of Jesus Christ
- 7. The humanity of Jesus Christ: called "a man," 8:40; appearance at the wedding at Cana, John 2; tired and thirsty at the well, John 4; grieving and weeping, John 11:35; thirsting on the Cross
- 8. Reactions to Jesus: believe or reject.
- 9. Light and darkness
- 10. Life and eternal life; death
- 11. Testimony, witness
- 12. Truth
- 13. Believe. The word appears 99 times!
- 14. Glory
- 15. Love
- 16. Signs (attesting miracles).
- 17. Abiding (dwelling, remaining) in Jesus
- 18. The Holy Spirit, particularly in John 14-16, but also 3:5, 8; 7:39; 20:22.
- 19. Water
- 20. Jesus specifically said to be the "the Word" in 1:1-14. The meaning is repeatedly explained and illustrated in the remainder of the book.
