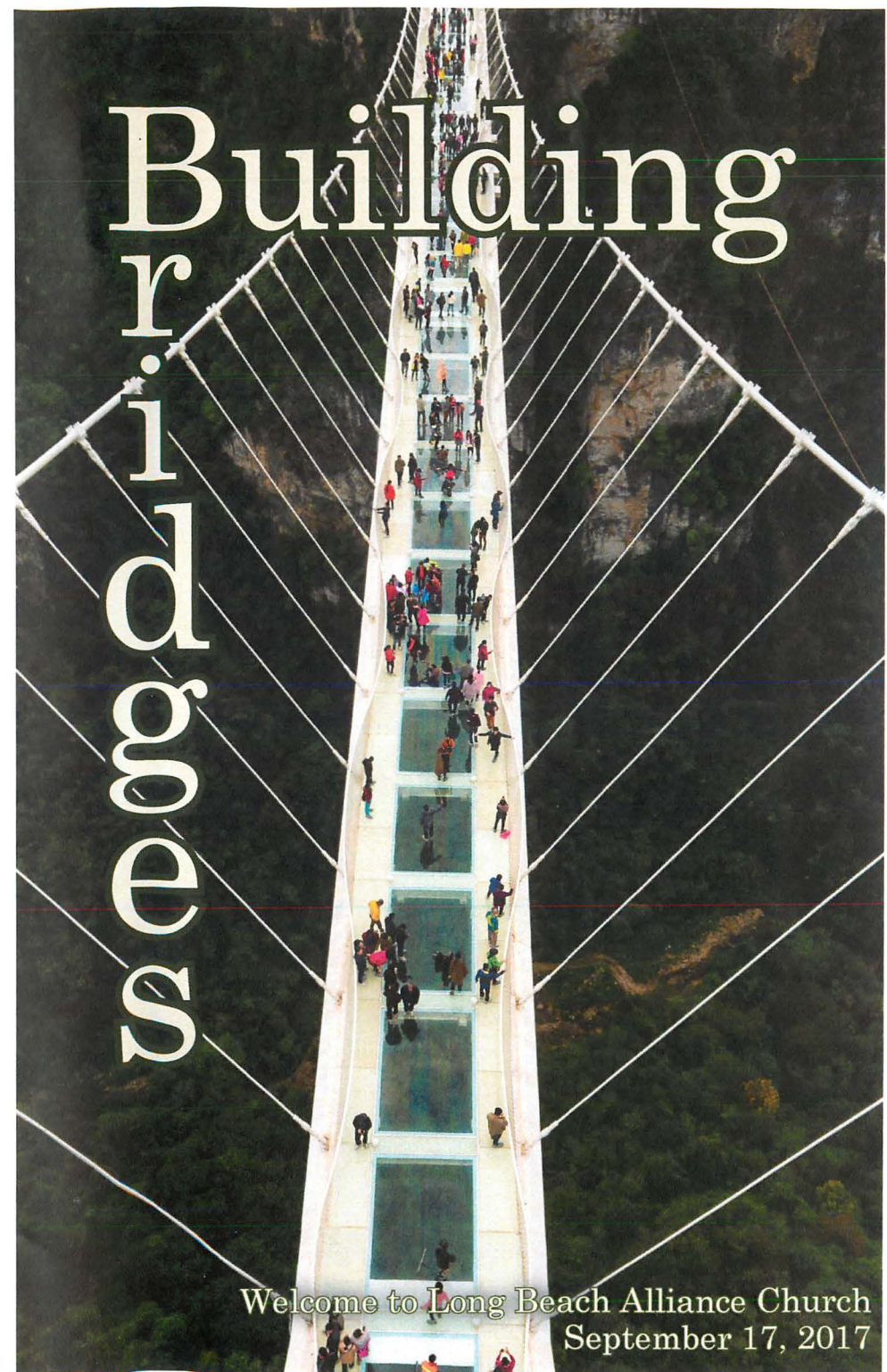

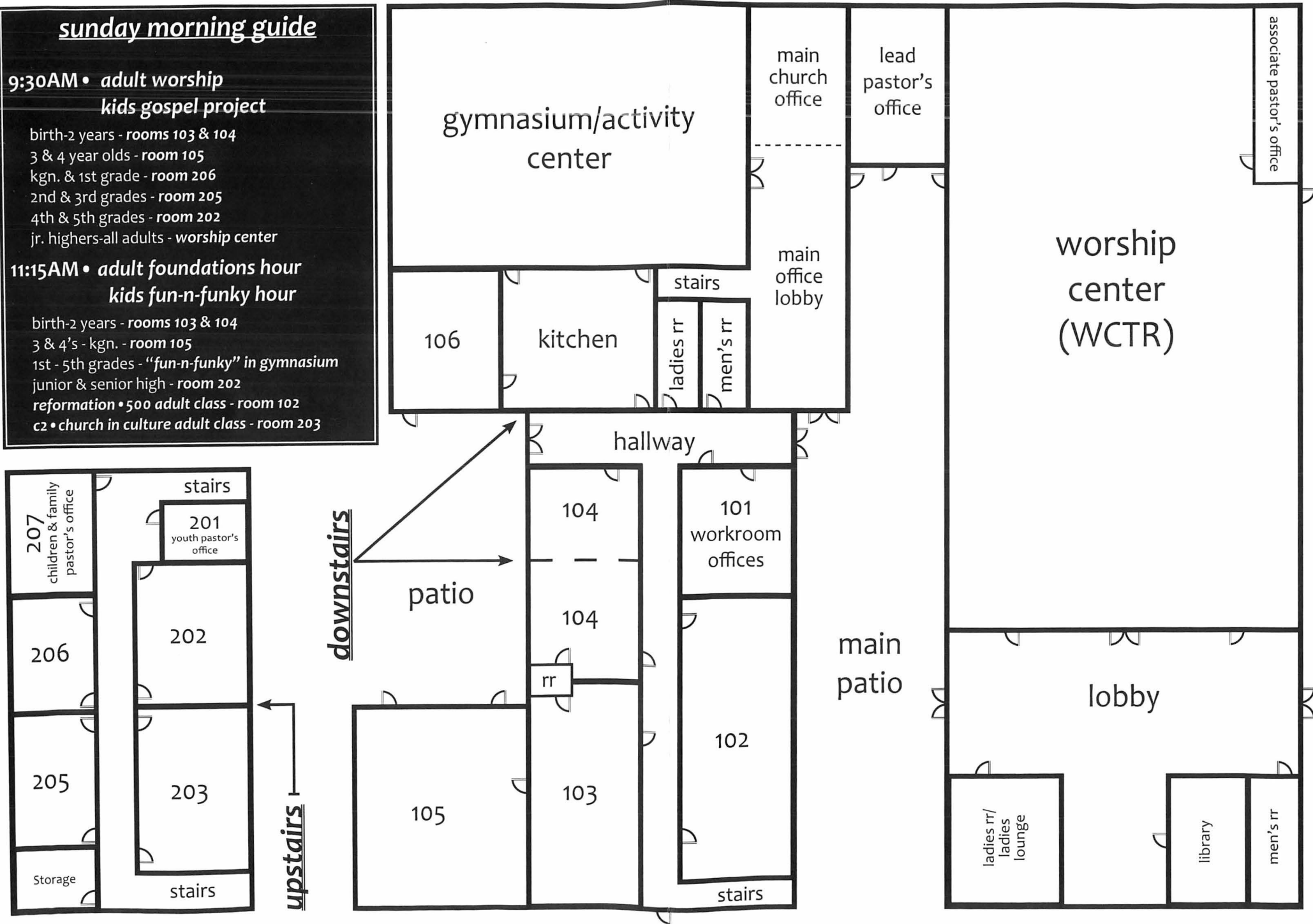

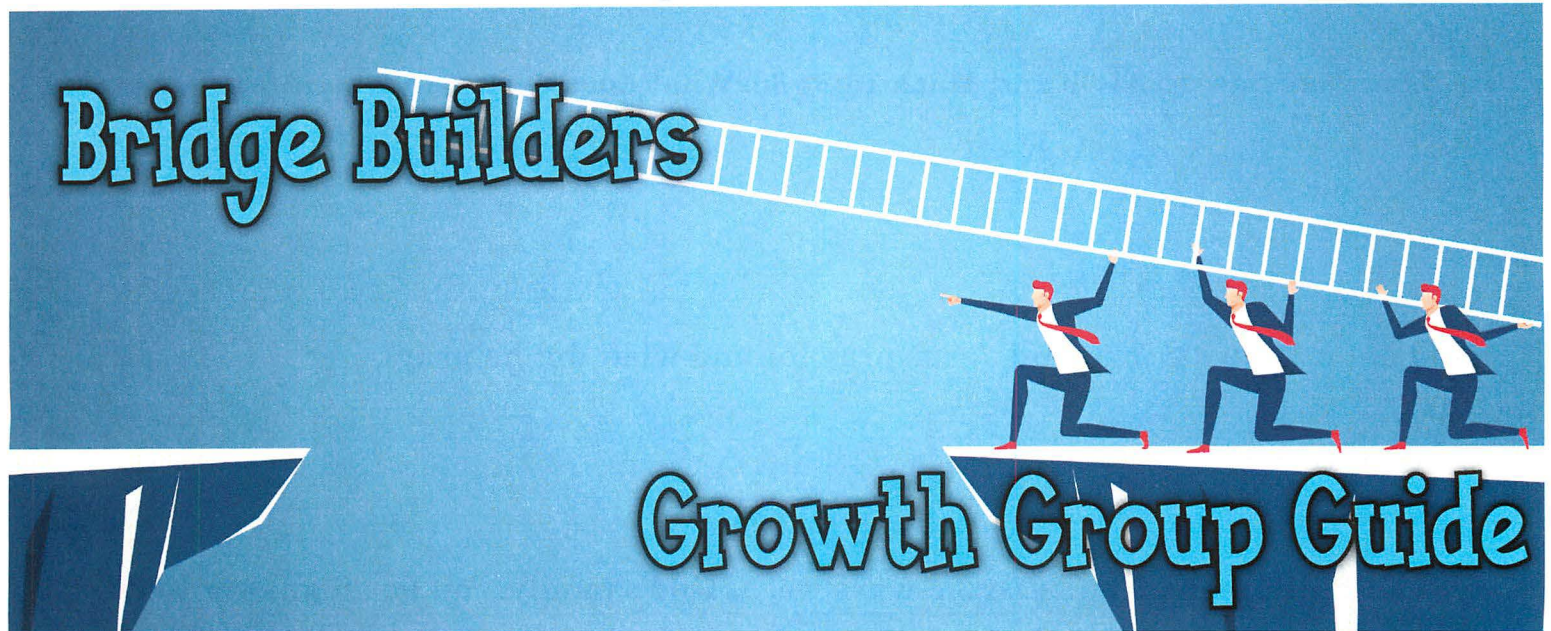

Ice Breaker

- Who is the most unusual member of your extended family (e.g. “crazy Uncle Joe”)? What makes them unique and how does your family react to it?

In-Depth

- *Read Mark 3:31-35*
- *Discuss what you learned from this week’s sermon.*

1. Verse 31: Read Mark 6:3. Who was Jesus’ (earthly) family?

A. Verses 32-33: Read Mark 3:21-22. What might have been the family’s motivation for coming? What was Jesus’ reaction to them?

B. Read John 7:1-8: Is the advice from Jesus’ brothers good? Why?

2. Verses 34-35: What is Jesus saying about family?

A. Read Matthew 10:34-39 and Mark 10:29-30. What does Jesus say about family here?

3. Read John 17:20-23: Who did Jesus pray for and what did he pray?

A. Read *Philippians* 2:1-4: List 3-5 ways we, as God's family, can be an answer to Jesus' prayer.

Making It Relevant

1. Jesus' brothers eventually become followers (Acts 1:14, James 1:1, Jude 1). We can take encouragement that, like Jesus' brothers, those we love who don't believe may someday do so. Pray for them!
2. Of the list you created in 3A above, which one(s) do you need to work on, "that they may become perfectly one" (John 17:23).
