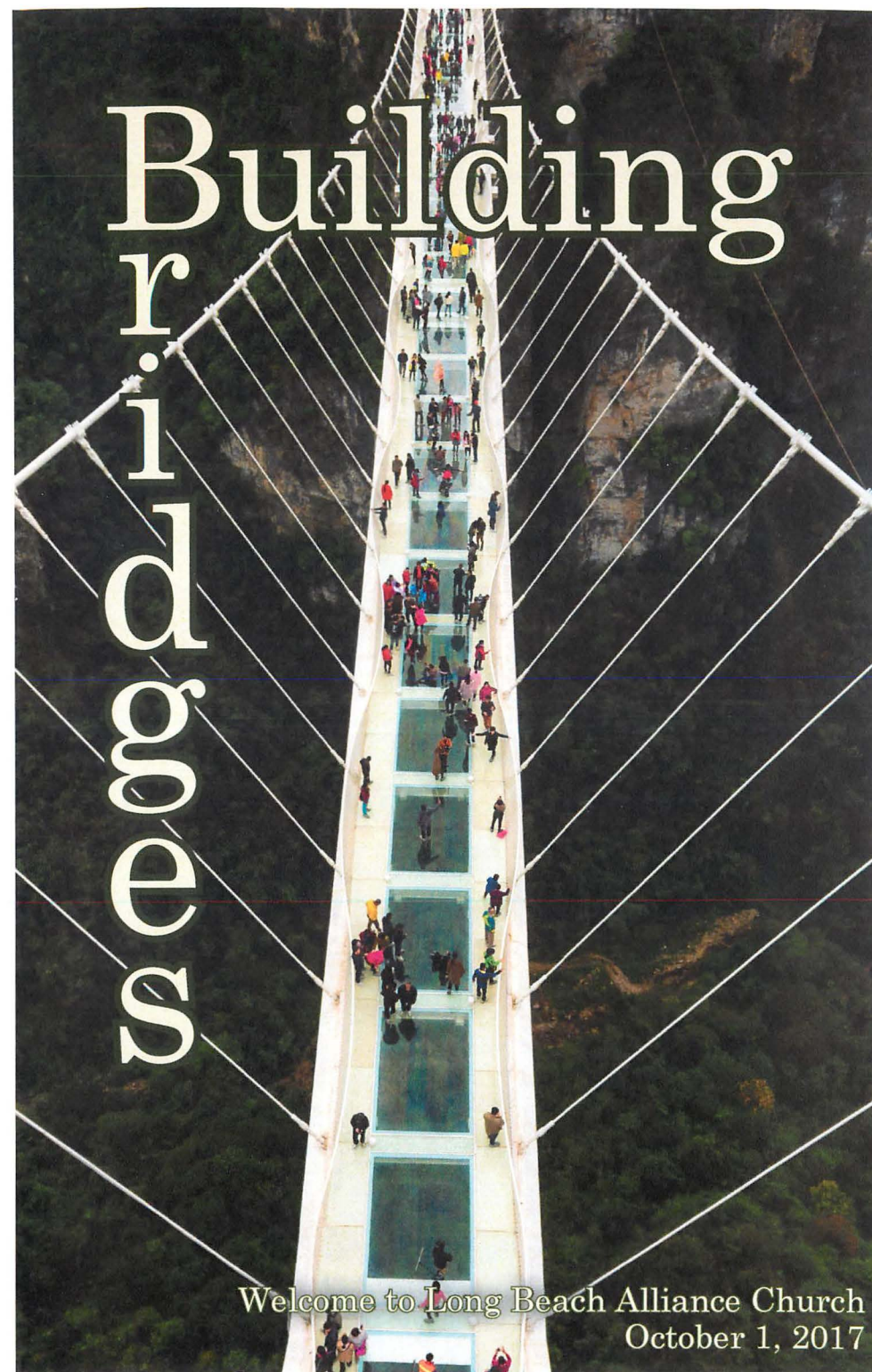

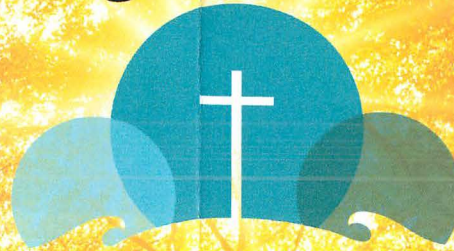

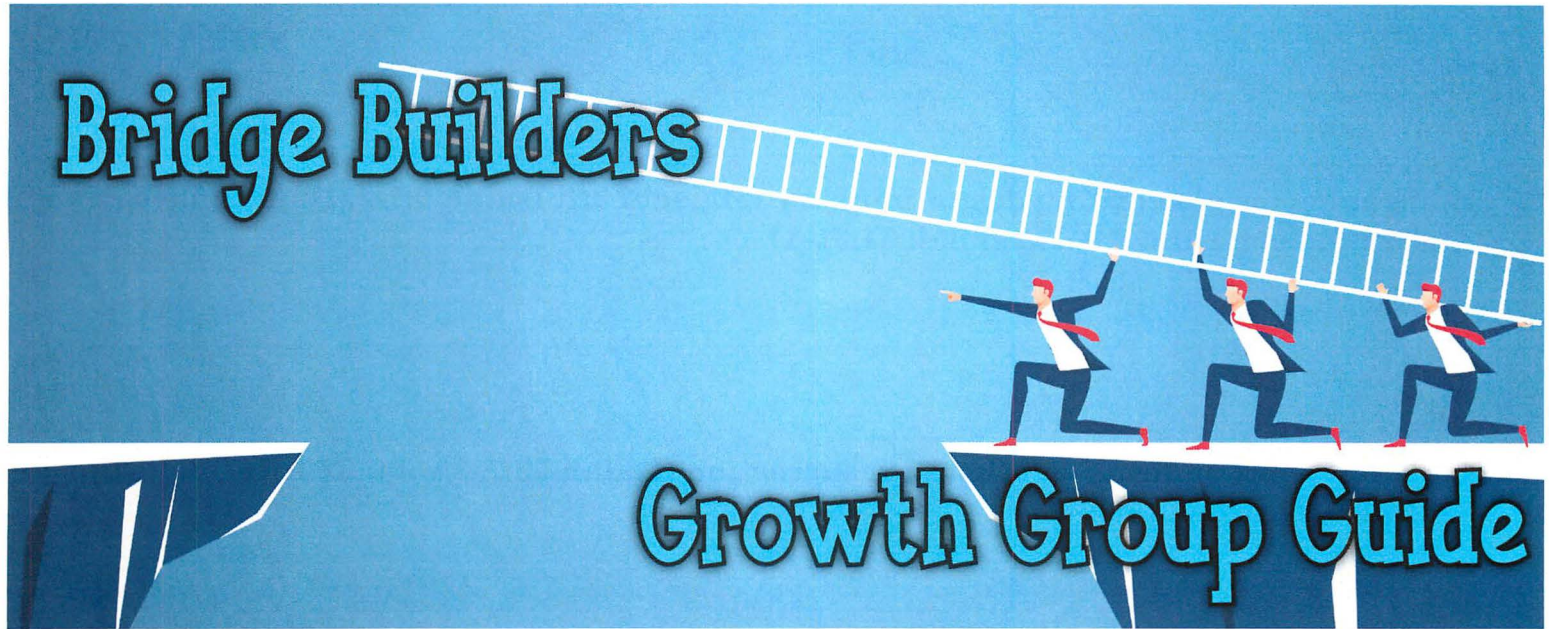

- *Read Luke 7:18-23*
 - *Discuss what you learned from this week's sermon.*
1. Luke 7:24-25. What is Jesus' saying about John in these verses? Why?
 2. Luke 7:26-27. Read Luke 3:1-18. Some prophets of God came to proclaim a message from God for now, others to foresee the future. Which of these does John do?
 - 2A. In what way was John "more than a prophet"?
 3. Jesus uses the prophecy about John as proof that Jesus is the Messiah. Let's look more deeply at other prophecies about Jesus. For each, list the prophecy, and, if possible, where it is foretold in the OT:

3A. Prophecies of Jesus' lineage and birth (e.g. Isaiah 7:14, Isaiah 9:6-7, Micah 5:2, Jeremiah 31:15)

3B. Prophecies concerning Jesus' ministry (Malachi 3:1, Isaiah 9:1-2, Isaiah 35:5-6, Isaiah 53:1-3, Zechariah 9:9, Jeremiah 31:31-34)

3C. Prophecies of Jesus' death and resurrection (Isaiah 53:7, Psalm 22:1, 16-18, Psalm 16:10, Matthew 17:22-23)

4. Verse 28. What is Jesus' message about the kingdom of God?
