

# Philippians 3:9-21

Introduction

# I. What is this Goal? (Philippians 3:10-11)

- A. To know Christ and the Power that resurrected Him
- B. Experiencing His power
- C. Sharing in His sufferings
- D. Being made like Jesus in death
- E. Experiencing resurrection from the dead (Daniel 12:2; John 5:29; Acts 24:15; 1 Corinthians 15:23; 1 Thessalonians. 4:16).

# II. Running the Race (Philippians 3:12-14)

- A. Press on no matter the cost Philippians 3:12
- B. Paul admits that he has not obtained all the things, neither is he perfect Philippians 3:12
- C. You cannot obtain the prize if you quit the race (Philippians 2:12-13; 1 Corinthians 9:24-27, 1 Timothy 6:12;
- 2 Timothy 4:7-8; Matthew 24:3; Hebrews 12:1)
- D. Focus on what lies ahead, not behind Phil. 3:13 (Forgetting-Not losing all memory of his sinful past, but leaving it behind as done with or settled cf. Philippians. 3:4-6; 2 Corinthians 5:17)
- E. Never give up on the Prize Philippians 3:14, 2 Timothy 4:8 (Paul says in Philippians 1:21 "For to me to live is Christ, to die is gain", and the key is not how you started the race with Jesus, but how you finish).
- F. Christians receive an award of everlasting glory-Heaven (Colossians 3:1-2).

# III. The High Calling of God in Christ (Philippians 3:14)

- A. A call to repentance or salvation (Acts 17:30)
- B. A call to a complete dedication (1 Corinthians 1:9; Romans 1:6; 1 Corinthians 3:4)
- C. A call for service, or ministry, or a holy living (2 Timothy 1:9; Acts 13:2; Geneis 12:1; Matthew 28:19)
- (cf, John 1:35-51; Luke 5:1-11; Matthew 10:1-5)

# IV. Mature Christians must realize that they are not perfect (Philippians 3:15-17)

- A. The Philippian Christians were to note that they had not yet arrived spiritually, likewise ourselves Philippians 3: 12-15
- B. God will reveal our erroneous belief to us as well (1 Corinthias 2:6; 3:1-3; Hebrews 5:14)
- C. We are responsible for the truth we already possess Philippians 3:16
- D. Paul asks the Philippian Christians to imitate him as he imitates Christ Philippians 3:17
- E. The life-styles of Christians should be models worth following Philippians 3:17-18
- F. There are enemies of the Cross Philippians 3:18-19
  - i) Their end or destiny is destruction-eternal punishment
  - ii) Their god is their belly-they worship their sensual desires, sexual immorality, lusts
  - iii) Their glory or reputation consists of in their shame
  - iv) Their mind is on earthly things rather than heavenly things

### V. For our citizenship is in Heaven (Philippians 3:20)

- A. In this world, Christians are aliens, strangers, even though we are fully involved in it (John 17:14-16; 1 Corinthians 7:29-31; 1 Peter 2:11)
- B. Christians are awaiting for our Savior Jesus Christ Philippians 3:20 (Romans 8:19; 1 Corinthians 1:7; 1 Thessalonians 1:9—10; 2 Timothy 4:8)
- C. When Christ returns He will change our lowly bodies Philippians 3: 21
  - i) Our new bodies will be made like unto His glorious body (Romans 8:29; 1 Corinthians 6:14; 15:50-51; 1 John 3:2)
  - ii) There will be a future resurrection for believers in Christ (1 Corinthians 15:20, 44,46,49)

### **VI.** Condusion

Let us level up this coming 2018 year-level up your prayer life, fellowship, your system of giving and serving. Don't be late in the church. Keep up the good work in the church, school, family, in the community etc. Continue investing in your service to God. Jesus is coming very soon. Be ready for the appearing of the Lord Jesus in the clouds. Let us never quit our pursuit of knowing Christ and growing in Him.
