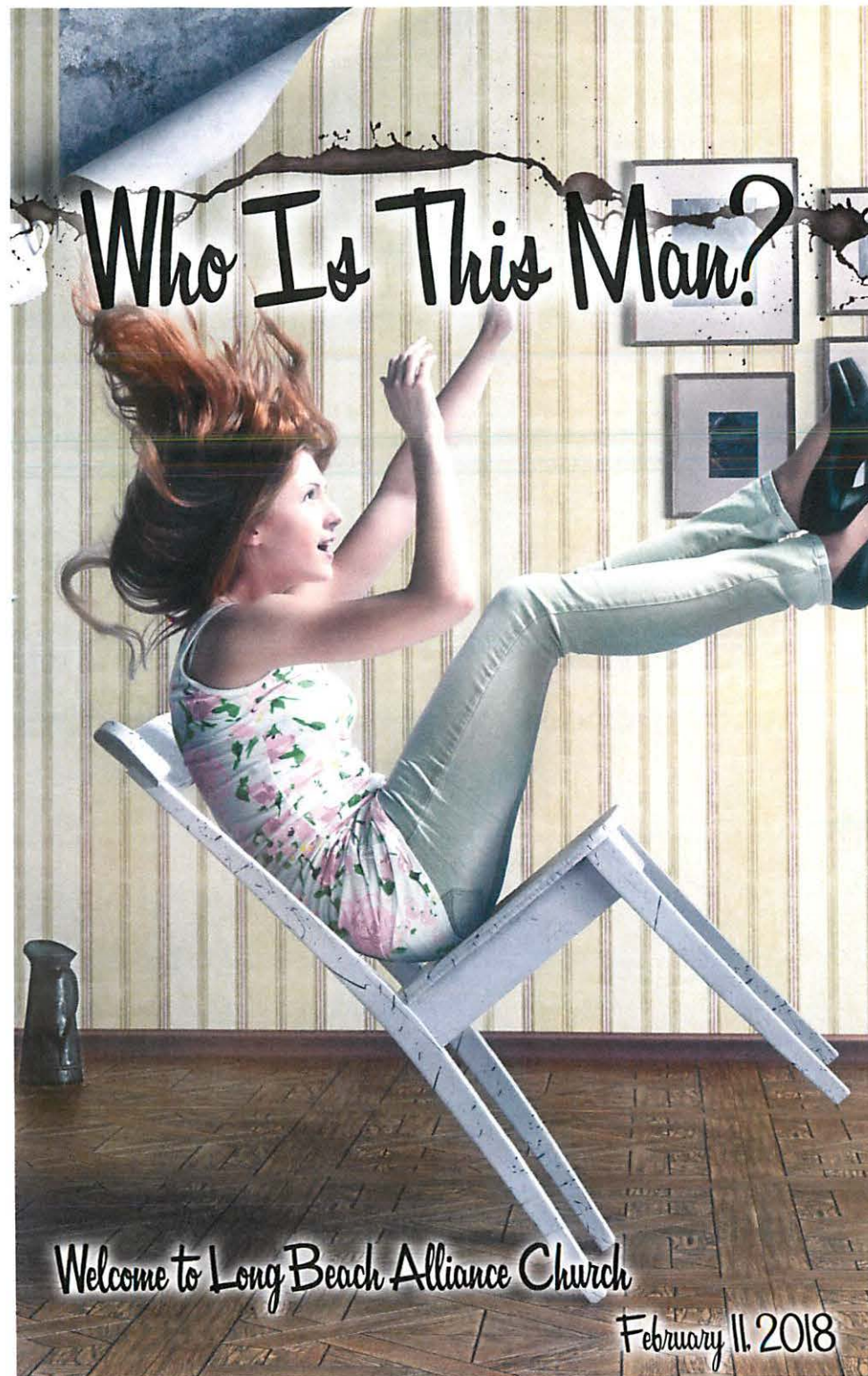

Luke 9:28-36

Ice Breaker

- Do you have a favorite mountain experience? What made it special?

In-Depth

- Read Luke 9:28-36
 - Discuss what you learned from this week's sermon
1. Read Luke 9:26, 29-32. These verses all speak of "glory." What does "glory" mean?

1A. God's "Shekinah glory" is often revealed in clouds and bright light (see Exodus 24:15-17; Exodus 34:29; Exodus 40:34-38; Ezekiel 1:27-28.) What is the significance of Jesus' visible glory?

1B. When will we again see the Shekinah glory of God? (See Matthew 24:30-31; Revelation 21:22-27.)

2. Luke 9:30-31. What were Moses and Elijah discussing with Jesus? What is the significance of the discussion?
3. Luke 9:33. Also Mark 9:5-6. What was Peter's motivation for his suggestion, and why was it off the mark?
4. Luke 9:34-35. . Also read Luke 3:21-22. What is God saying about Jesus? What does he mean by "my Son"?
5. Read 2 Peter 1:13-19, John 1:14. What impact did this event have on the disciples? Why were they allowed to witness this event?

Making It Relevant

1. Do you yearn to see God's glory or are you living for today?
2. Luke 9:35. "This is my Son...listen to him!" How well do you listen to Jesus? Are you listening as if he is God's Son or merely a good teacher?
3. Have you ever made a "suggestion" to God? Would you have been better off just listening?
