Sanctification is a progressive/ongoing renewing by God's Spirit among all Disciples of Jesus.

Sanctification reflects God's holiness, and is the basis for discipleship – becoming more like Jesus.

2) Disciples Who Make Disciples Who Make Disciples Who...

• Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; Colossians 1:28-29

When a person follows Christ, they become a disciple of Jesus called to make disciples of Jesus.

A Disciple is characterized by sound beliefs/thinking about God, known as “orthodoxy.”

A Disciplemaker intentionally creates environments where orthodoxy is taught & learned.

A Disciple is characterized by sound behaviors/actions reflecting God, known as “orthopraxis.”

A Disciplemaker intentionally creates environments where orthopraxis is practiced & measured.

A Disciple is characterized by sound passions/affection worshipping God, known as “orthokardia.”

A Disciplemaker intentionally creates environments where orthokardia is engaged & enjoyed.

A Disciple is characterized by intentional multiplication, known as “disciplemaking.”

Disciplemaking is the relationship of intentionally expansive sanctification among fellow disciples.
