# Killing By The Rules

# 1) Dirty Hands, Dirty Dishes, Dirty Hearts (Luke 11:37-41; Matthew 15:1-9; Mark 7:1-9)

Cleaning your hands and feet (note Genesis 18:4, Judges 19:21) were a common pre-meal practice for the Jews. But the Pharisees and Scribes had taken an 'observed' (optional) tradition and made it into a set of 'prescribed' (required) rules required for eating any food (see Mark 7:3).

Whether Jesus purposely initiated this conversation (by not washing) or this was simply His normal practice; it is clear Jesus wants to 'shine some light' (cf. Luke 11:33-36) on a dirty-little-secret of the Pharisees. Like a laser beam into the darkness, Jesus exposes the wickedness and dangers of following religious rules in order to 'be good' with God.


Following man made traditions and rules which replace the actual Word of God revealed in the Bible is a poisonous recipe for eternal death. This practice, known as legalism, remains a cancerous force in every modern-day church. Jesus cries out "Woe to those..." rule following fools!

# 2) Following the Rules Can Lead to Hell (Luke 11:42-54; Matthew 23:13-39; Isaiah 29:13; Ezekiel 33:30-32)

In a series of 6 (Luke) or 7 (Matthew) "woe's" (pity and pain for the terrible misfortune awaiting those in these dire conditions), Jesus sharply and surgically condemns the Pharisees for their hypocrisy, calloused hearts, pride, and desire for notoriety.

When the Scribes begin to object to Jesus' harsh characterization of their Pharisee comrades, Jesus raises the temperature, unleashing white-hot condemnation on the lawyers/Scribes for their hypocrisy, heartless legalism, deceptive leadership, and false teaching.

The darkness of Israel's leaders sets the stage for their desire to snuff out the Light of Christ (Luke 11:35-36), and marches us ever closer to the ultimate climax of Jerusalem & the death of Jesus at Golgotha.
