Where there is mutual abiding, where the words of Jesus form the fresh starting point from which discipleship begins at every moment, these four things follow-and all because the words of Jesus are the mighty acts of the Father. The 4 things are answered prayer, glory to the Father, abundant fruit, and recognition of the disciples of Jesus. And these four are closely bound together. If the words of Jesus form the foundation and context of all our doing, they will necessarily shape the prayers we offer, and these will truly be prayers through Jesus Christ our Lord, which the Father will grant. The answer to the prayers will take the form of much fruit, and so the Gardener will be glorified, in the abundant Jesus, so he will be glorified in the mission of the church, of which intercession will be a central part. And because the fruit will be the genuine fruit of the true vine, it will lead people to recognize the branches as true branches. People will give glory to the Father.
