HELP FOR PARADISE ALLIANCE CHURCH



Dear South Pacific Alliance Family,

November 15, 2018

We have all been watching and praying as we follow the horrific news of what will go down as one of the most terrible and destructive fires in California history. Paradise, CA is anything but “paradise” for the people and the family members of those who have lost their lives. Thousands of structures and homes have burned to the ground, often with no time to go in and recover possessions of a lifetime. There are now 56 confirmed dead and scores of people yet to be found.

In speaking with Ray Van Gilst, my counterpart for the Central Pacific District of The Alliance, he described the scene as horrible and the loss of life and homes as devastating. **While our sister church, Paradise Alliance Church, miraculously is still standing, as many as 16 pastor and staff homes have been burned to the ground. Seven of the people that call Paradise Alliance their home are still missing.** It is being report that nearly 200 people have yet to be found.

Alliance Family, we need your help! The greatest need now is financial. The church has become a place of refuge for the community, a staging area for help. So many people are seeking shelter and food. Compassion And Mercy Associates (CAMA), the relief arm of The Alliance, is now receiving funds and distributing them through our Alliance Central Pacific District. Checks can be directly be made out to CAMA. All the funds will go directly to the needs on the ground. The Central Pacific District is organized to administer the gifts. CAMA and the district is working directly with the Paradise Alliance Church.

Will you please take a special offering as soon as possible? In the case of your church, perhaps you have a benevolent or relief funds that can be made available. I can promise you that the dollars will be administered well and so many critical needs will be met.

My prayer for you is that you and your church will be blessed beyond measure for your generosity. Pray with me that our Lord Jesus will redeem the pain and suffering and bring people to Himself in all of this.
