God Love You More Than You Think

Week #4 • Luke 15:1-7

Ice Breaker

- Have you ever lost something, only to find it many months later? What was your reaction?
- Finalize plans. For your group to serve somewhere in the community.

In-Depth

- **Read Luke 15:1-7**
 - **Discuss what you learned from this week's sermon**
1. Luke 15:1-2. Also read Luke 5:29-32; 19:2,9-10. Compare the attitude of the Pharisees and Jesus toward the lost.
 2. Luke 15:3. What is a parable? What are some characteristics of parables? Why speak in parables?
 3. Luke 15:4-6. Explain the literal meaning of this story, in the context of the time and place.
 - A. Explain the spiritual meaning of this story.

4. Luke 15:7. Also read Deuteronomy 30:9-10; Hebrews 12:2. What is the common message of these verses?

A. Do you think of joy as an attribute of God? Read 1 Chronicles 16:27; Nehemiah 8:10; Jeremiah 32:37-41; Zephaniah 3:17; John 15:11; Romans 14:17. How do these add to your understanding of our Great God?

5. Luke 15:7. Is Jesus suggesting the Pharisees are like the 99 righteous people?

Making It Relevant

1. Read Matthew 10:14-15. When are we to pursue the lost like in this parable and when should we "shake off the dust"?

2. In what ways do Christians have attitudes toward the lost that are similar to those of the Pharisees?

3. Read Romans 10:14-17. What is our responsibility toward the lost?
