In-Depth

- **Read Luke 15:8-10**
- **Discuss what you learned from this week's sermon**

1. Luke 15:8-10. Explain this story, in the context of the time and place.

A. Explain the spiritual meaning of this story.

B. What are some similarities and differences between this parable and the parable of the lost sheep in Luke 15:1-7?

2. This parable is one picture of the value God places in redeeming the lost. Another is through the concept of redemption. Define "redeem." What does redemption mean in the context of salvation?

A. Read Leviticus 25:23-28; 47-49. How did redemption work in ancient Israel?

B. Read John 8:34; Romans 6:16; Hebrews 2:15. Why do we need to be redeemed?

C. Read Mark 10:45; Galatians 4:4-7; 1 Peter 1:18-19; Hebrews 9:11-15; Revelation 5:9. How much did Jesus pay to redeem us from slavery to sin? What does this say about God's love for us?

3. Redemption is just one of many words used in scripture to describe important salvation concepts. What do each of these communicate about salvation:

A. *Forgiveness*

B. Atonement

C. Adoption

D. Reconciliation

E. Sanctification
