1. Luke 16:19-23. Contrast the rich man and Lazarus before death.

A. In what ways were their roles reversed after death?

2. Luke 16:24-26. What is Jesus teaching about hell in this parable?

A. Read Hebrews 9:27; Matthew 25:46; 2 Thessalonians 1:9; 2 Peter 2:4; Matthew 16:18; Revelation 21:8. What does the Bible teach about Hell?

3. Luke 16:27-31. What did Abraham mean by, “They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them?”

A. How were people in the Old Testament saved, since Jesus had not yet come? (See John 14:6; Romans 4:1-6; 16-17; Galatians 3:8-11; 23-24)
