Crisis Formation

LONG BEACH ALLIANCE CHURCH * MAY 26. 2019 * PASTOR CHRIS LANKFORD 1) POSITIONAL, PROGRESSIVE, & Perfecting Spiritual Formation

- A. SALVATION FROM GOD TRANSFORMS A PERSON FROM BEING SPIRITUALLY DEAD INTO A NEW SPIRITUALLY ALIVE PERSON (EPHESIANS 2:4-9). JESUS CALLED THIS CHANGE BEING "BORN AGAIN" (JOHN 3:3-6).
- B. BECAUSE GOD IS PERFECT (OR HOLY), HE REQUIRES HIS PEOPLE TO ALSO BE HOLY (LEVITICUS 19:2, 20:7, 26). SINCE WE CANNOT ACHIEVE PERFECTION, GOD THE SON JESUS CHRIST, FULFILLS THIS REQUIREMENT HIMSELF (HEBREWS 10:10-14).
- C. A PERSON SAVED BY FAITH IN JESUS CHRIST OBTAINS CHRIST'S SPIRITUALLY HOLY LIFE (HEBREWS 10:14), THEY ARE "POSITIONALLY SANCTIFIED," OR GIVEN A HOLY IDENTITY (ACTS 26:16-18: 1 CORINTHIANS 1:2, 30, 6:11, 2 CORINTHIANS 1:1: 2 THESSALONIANS 2:13-15: HEBREWS 2:10-14, 10:14: 1 PETER 1:2).
- D. THE REST OF A PERSON'S SPIRITUAL AND PHYSICAL LIFE IS THEN SPIRITUALLY FORMED INTO THIS NEW IDENTITY (PROGRESSIVE SANCTIFICATION - ROMANS 6:19, 12:1-2, 6:13-14: COLOSSIANS 3:12-17: 1 THESSALONIANS 4:3-8: 2 TIMOTHY 2:21-26: HEBREWS 10:14: 1 PETER 1:13-16, 22-25).
- E. WHILE THIS SPIRITUAL FORMATION WILL NEVER BE COMPLETE ON THIS SIDE OF HEAVEN (PHILIPPIANS 3:12-16), WE ARE PROMISED THAT GOD WILL COMPLETE THE WORK OF HOLINESS IN EACH OF US (COMPLETE/PERFECT SANCTIFICATION -ROMANS 6:22-23: 1 CORINTHIANS 13:12: 2 CORINTHIANS 3:17-18: EPHESIANS 1:13-14: PHILIPPIANS 1:6: 1 THESSALONIANS 5:23).
- F. THE MEANS OF SANCTIFICATION ARE THE WORD OF GOD (JOHN 17:17-19) APPLIED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT (JOHN 14:26, 16:13-14: 2 CORINTHIANS 3:17-18) IN COMPLETE IDENTITY WITH JESUS CHRIST (GALATIANS 2:20) WHO BRINGS US PEACE WITH GOD (ROMANS 5:1-2: 1 THESSALONIANS 5:23-24).

2) The Crisis Experience in Progressive Spiritual Formation

- A. MANY (IF NOT MOST) FOLLOWERS OF JESUS CHRIST WILL EXPERIENCE AN ONGOING AND GRADUAL "GROWTH-CYCLE" IN BOTH THEIR KNOWLEDGE AND THEIR OBEDIENCE TO A SPIRIT-LED-CHRIST-CENTERED-GOD-GLORIFYING LIFE (COLOSSIANS 3:1-17).
- B. BUT AT TIMES, THE HOLY SPIRIT CAN LEAD A PERSON THROUGH (WHAT A.B. SIMPSON, FOUNDER OF THE CHRISTIAN & MISSIONARY ALLIANCE PHRASED) IS AN INTENTIONAL "CRISIS SANCTIFICATION" EXPERIENCE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

- C ACCORDING TO THE C&MA STATEMENT OF FAITH. "CRISIS SANCTIFICATION" IS A UNIQUE POST-SALVATION EXPERIENTIAL ASPECT OF PROGRESSIVE SANCTIFICATION MARKED BY A COMPLETE SUBMISSION TO THE HOLY SPIRIT OF THE ENTIRE PERSON LEADING TO A DEEPER AND FULLER FILLING OF HOLY SPIRIT POWER AND DIVINE LIFE IN THE BELIEVER (ROMANS 6:1-14: 2 PETER 1:3-4: 1 TIMOTHY 6:17: 1 PETER 5:10).
- D. DISTINGUISHING HIMSELF (AND THE C&MA) FROM SOME OF THE POPULAR TEACHING OF HIS DAY (KESWICK & WESLEYAN THEOLOGY), SIMPSON EMPHASIZED THAT SUPPRESSION OF SIN AND/OR THE MORTIFICATION OF THE BODY (NOTE ROMANS 8:13: COLOSSIANS 3:5-8) WERE "THE LOW WAY OF MAN'S VAIN AND FRUITLESS" SELF-IMPROVEMENT PERFECTION EFFORTS, AND LED TO INEFFECTIVE AND TOILSOME STRUGGLES WHICH COULD NOT MOVE YOU ONE INCH IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION.
- E. A.B. SIMPSON'S SAID, "JUSTIFICATION BRING US PEACE <u>WITH</u> GOD, SANCTIFICATION, THE PEACE <u>OF</u> GOD." SPIRITUAL FORMATION IS PEACE WITH GOD, HARMONY WITH THE SPIRIT, AND ABIDING IN CHRIST AS A NEW CREATION (2 CORINTHIANS 5:17).
- F. FOR THE ONE LIVING "IN CHRIST JESUS" (I CORINTHIANS 1:26-31), FOLLOWING GOD IS NOT FILLED WITH FRUITLESS SELF-EFFORT, BUT ACTUALLY LACKS BURDEN (MATTHEW 11:28-29: 1 John 5:3-5), The Goal ISN'T EFFORT NOR IS IT FEELINGS-CENTERED, BUT, IT IS A SUBMITTED LIFE IN CHRIST, "WITHOUT FEELING, WITHOUT QUESTION, IN FULL ASSURANCE OF FAITH ON SIMPLE PROMISES" (JOHN 3:36, JOHN 6:35-37),
- G. FOR A "WHOLLY SANCTIFIED" PERSON, FOLLOWING GOD IS AS EFFORTLESS AS THE BURDEN OF GOD'S LAW OF GRAVITY. GRAVITY IS A POWERFUL FORCE OF THE EARTH'S MASS PULLING US CLOSE TO ITSELF (OR THE SUN'S MASS KEEPING OUR EARTH IN ORBIT CLOSE TO ITSELF). BUT LIKE THE LIFE OF THOSE SANCTIFIED IN CHRIST, WE LIVE EFFORTLESSLY AND FREELY UNDER THE "BURDEN" OF GRAVITY. SO IT IS WITH SANCTIFIED LIVING (HEBREWS 12:1-3).
- 3) Christ-Centered Living vs. Experiential-Centered Living
 - A. THE CRUCIAL ISSUE IN SPIRITUAL FORMATION IS JESUS (COLOSSIANS 3:1-4, 12-17). IF YOU WANT MORE FROM AN ANEMIC OR WEAK WALK WITH GOD, SEEK CHRIST. IF SIN HAS A GRIP ON YOU, SEEK CHRIST. IF YOU HAVE NEVER TRUSTED GOD BEFORE. SEEK CHRIST. AND IF YOU NEED TO TRUST HIM AGAIN FOR WHATEVER CHALLENGES LIE AHEAD, SEEK CHRIST. IN EVERYTHING & ALWAYS, SEEK CHRIST (ROMANS 1:16-17).
 - B. SOME PEOPLE TEACH THERE IS A "SECOND-BLESSING" FOR SOME (BUT NOT ALL) IN A DEEPER-COMMITMENT OR HIGHER-CALLING OF "TRUE LORDSHIP DISCIPLESHIP." DO NOT BE SWAYED BY FALSE TEACHERS. THERE IS CHRIST ALONE (I CORINTHIANS 2:1-5) AND HE IS ALL YOU NEED TODAY, TOMORROW, AND FOREVER (I PETER 5:6-11).
