1) Worship in the Temple of God

- A. WE KNOW (FROM THE PREVIOUS 5 WEEKS OF STUDIES/SERMONS) THAT SPIRITUAL FORMATION FROM AN INITIAL IDENTITY OF SEPARATION FROM GOD BEGINS WITH THE TRANSFORMATION WHICH SALVATION PROVIDES (EPHESIANS 2:1-10, ESP. VV. 8-9).
- B. SEPARATION FROM GOD (UNSAVED) TO SEPARATION FOR GOD (SAVED) IS AN IDENTITY TRANSFORMATION FROM UNHOLY (SINFUL) TO HOLY (PURE/COMPLETE/PERFECT). OR "SANCTIFICATION" (I CORINTHIANS 6:11). OUR SANCTIFICATION IS ACHIEVED BY CHRIST (HEBREWS 10:10, 14) AND RESULTS IN A LIFE "IN CHRIST" (2 CORINTHIANS 5:17-19: GALATIANS 2:20) OF PROGRESSIVE/CONTINUAL SANCTIFICATION (I PETER 1:13-16).
- C. SIMPLY SPEAKING, WHEN WE GENUINELY RECEIVE THE LOVE AND MERCY OF GOD THROUGH THE LIFE OF JESUS CHRIST, WE ARE CHANGED AND BEGIN LIVING IN A COMPATIBLE RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD'S PURPOSES (2 CORINTHIANS 6:16B-7:1).

2) Spiritual Formation Measures Our Christianity

- A. THE MOST IMPORTANT REASON WE SHOULD COMPATIBLY AND PASSIONATELY PURSUE SPIRITUAL FORMATION IS BECAUSE GOD HAS GRACIOUSLY MADE A WAY TO HAVE A RELATIONSHIP WITH HIM THROUGH JESUS CHRIST. GOD'S HOLINESS TERRIFIES (ISAIAH 6:1-7). BUT CHRIST'S PRECIOUS AND COSTLY SACRIFICE (I PETER 3:13-25) PROVIDES PEACE WITH GOD (ROMANS 5:1-2). OUR OBEDIENT RESPONSE RESPECTS HIS SACRIFICE.
- B. RESPONSIVE AND LIVELY SPIRITUAL FORMATION IS AN OUTWARD COMMITMENT TO EXCELLENCE WHICH BRINGS DIVINE LIVING (2 PETER 1:3-7) AND OPENS OUR HEARTS (RECEPTIVITY) TO HEARING GOD'S WORD (2 CORINTHIANS 6:11-16A: NOTE 6:16B-7:1). THE WORD OF GOD IS THE CONTENT OF SPIRITUAL FORMATION (JOHN 17:17).
- C. OUR ACTIVE PURSUIT OF GOD-GIVEN HOLINESS MATTERS TO GOD (I THESSALONIANS 4:7-12). THE WAY A PERSON LIVES REVEALS THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE GOSPEL (I CORINTHIANS 5:9-13). LIVE IN PEACE WITH EVERYONE (ROMANS 12:18: 1 PETER 3:11). BUT MOST OF ALL WITH FELLOW CHRIST-FOLLOWERS (HEBREWS 12:14) BECAUSE OUR CONTINUAL SPIRITUAL FORMATION AUTHENTICATES THE GOSPEL (JOHN 13:35).
- D. CHRIST FOLLOWERS LIVE DISTINCTIVELY IN RESPONSE TO GOD. HOW IS JESUS BEING REVEALED IN YOUR LIFE? ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT ARE THE WAYS IN WHICH CHRISTIANS LIVE IN DISTINCTION FROM THE WORLD (JAMES 4:1-5). IN WHAT WAYS DO WE LIVE WHOLLY DISTINCTIVE IN OUR SOCIAL MEDIA & INTERNET AGE?
