

#### Know God? 1) Do YOU

- A. As we prepare for our 2019 Vacation Bible School, we will take the five upcoming weeks (from today through the Sunday before VBS begins) to consider the daily themes for "VBS 2019: Power Up!" Using the motif of traditional video games, Power Up! begins by asking, "do you know God?"
- B. Before we dive into that topic though, let's point out a VERY IMPORTANT caution. We live during one of the most technologically advanced AND theologically precise times in the history of mankind. I put those together because it is possible to know a lot ABOUT God, but not KNOW God.
- C. J.I. Packer, author of "Knowing God" (you should read it) said this:

The question is not whether we are good at theology, or "balanced" (horrible, self- conscious word!) in our approach to problems of Christian living. The question is, can we say, simply, honestly, not because we feel that as evangelicals we ought to, but because it is a plain matter of fact, that we have known God, and that because we have known God the unpleasantness we have had, or the pleasantness we have not had, through being Christians does not matter to us? If we really knew God, this is what we would be saying, and if we are not saying it, that is a sign that we need to face ourselves more sharply with the difference between knowing God and merely knowing about him.

D. Before we can lead others into knowing God, we must know God ourselves. What ability do we have to lead someone into something we ourselves know little or nothing about? Knowledge of God is only of value if it leads us to a life of authentic relationship and genuine transformation (1 Peter 1:3-4).

#### 2) Can Шe Know God?

- A. From the beginning, God created mankind to have a relationship with Him (Genesis 1:26-28; 2:15-25; 3:8-9). Even when mankind walks away from God, God preserves mankind (7:1, 9:1-7, 12-13), and even chooses to take one man and woman (Abram & Sarai) as God's own chosen people (12:1-4).
- B. Despite mankind's self-centered lack of interest in God (Romans 3:10b-18), God promises He will be faithful (Genesis 15:1-5) in saving mankind (Psalm 8).
- C. The Bible is God's self-revelation (2 Peter 1:21) of His patient (2 Peter 3:9) and consistent plan (Hebrews 1:1-3a) of seeking relationship with mankind (Ephesians 1:3-6) for our own delight in God (Psalm 34:8) and so that we might become participants in His wondrous plans (2 Corinthians 5:17-21).
