

1) It's Almost "Power Up" Time!

A. We are only ONE week from VBS! Today we continue to prepare ourselves for the crush of hundreds of kids and enthusiastic (!) volunteers who will fill Long Beach Alliance Church for our 2019 Vacation Bible School "VBS 2019: Power Up!"

B. In previous weeks we have prepared for VBS by learning:

- God has made us for relationships with each other and especially for a relationship with a good Father God, (and that...)
- The Bible is God's story explaining how great our lives can be if we have a true and genuine relationship with God, (and that...)
- God the Father sent His Son Jesus the Christ to pay a ransom for mankind, solving the problem of sin and death and providing the only bridge for relationship between God and mankind through the forgiveness of sin and promise of a renewed life "in Christ."
- C. So... now what? What is supposed to happen once I "receive" or "accept" Jesus as my Savior & Lord? Where do I go from here?

2) The Marching Orders of Jesus

A. When you receive Jesus Christ, God places a "seal" (like a family crest or coat of arms) of the Holy Spirit within your heart/soul (John 14:26-27; Romans 8:16-17). The Spirit uses the Bible (God's Word) to remind & teach us (John 16:13-15) and to provide whatever power is needed to live for God in this world (Acts 1:8).

The U.S.A. Christian & Missionary Alliance is part of a Christ-centered global movement of more than 6 million Christ followers. We are an Acts 1:8 family inspired by Jesus love and empowered by His Spirit; passionate to bring the good news about Him to our neighborhoods and world.

- B. Our ultimate goal is to "make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:18-20) who will also go and make disciples in the power of the Holy Spirit (Colossians 1:28-29). The Spirit of God provides character change (Galatians 5:22-23) and equips us with powerful gifts (Romans 12; 1 Corinthians 12) to serve inside the church (Ephesians 4:1-16) and to go and make disciples of people who remain outside of Christ and His Church (2 Corinthians 5:17-21).
- C. When we experience a "power outage" in our spiritual lives, it is often because we forget our ultimate purpose of being disciples WHO MAKE DISCIPLES (Revelation 2:4). Return again to receive all Christ has for you (Romans 12:1-2) in the power of His Spirit (2 Peter 1:3-4) for the purpose of reflecting Christ with authentic transparency for everyone everywhere (Colossians 3:12-17).
