



Summer of Psalms (S.O.P.'s)

Long Beach Alliance Church • August 18, 2019 • Pastor Chris Lankford

1) Psalm 16 - Who's In & Who's Out

A. Taking "refuge" in God (Psalm 16:1-4) stands strong in the face of wicked opposition (cf. Psalm 11:1-3). This leads to a declaration of loyalty (cf. Psalm 23:1) authenticated in WHO one associates and in WHAT one "delights" (cf. Psalm 106:36-38; see Deuteronomy 7:6, 14:2, also Leviticus 19:2).

2) Intentional Trust

- A. Trust in the Lord is never automatic! Faith in God does not come because of your family, nation, or by our feelings. It is God's divine choice to call us to Himself (1 Timothy 2:4; 2 Peter 3:9, see also Ephesians 1:4-5) to which we must intentionally respond with active and ongoing faithfulness to God (Psalm 16:5-6)!
- B. As we "walk by faith and not by sight" (cf. 2 Corinthians 5:7, see also Psalm 20:7) our lives are re-oriented to our "beautiful inheritance" of ongoing divine guidance from God (Psalm 16:7-8, see also Psalm 17:3; John 17:17; Joel 2:28; Acts 2:17; Romans 5:5).

3) Don't Worry, Be Happy!

- A. Where does happiness come from? Happiness does not come from pursuing what this world has to offer, but rather in "blessing the Lord" ('making Him happy,' Psalm 16:7) by seeking God's glory foremost (Psalm 57:5).
- B. Does God care about your happiness? YES! But not as the world defines happiness (cf. John 14:27). We are designed for something greater than this world, which means our deepest happiness (blessing) comes from God, and not from this world (Psalm 16:9-10).
- C. This is ultimately fulfilled in Christ Jesus (cf. Acts 2:25-31), and is our source of pleasure and happiness forever (Psalm 16:11).
