IN-DEPTH

- Read 2 Kings 5:1-14
- Discuss what you learned from this week's sermon

1. The Sovereignty of God

- A. Read 1 Chronicles 29:11-12; Proverbs 21:1; Isaiah 46:9-11; Romans 13:1-2. What is the sovereignty of God? Does it have limits?
- B. 2 Kings 5:1-5. How is God's sovereignty revealed in these verses? Why would God help Naaman? Is Naaman aware of it?
- C. Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-31. What is Paul's point here? What does "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord" mean?

2. The Pride of Mankind

- A. <u>2 Kings 5:6-14</u>. Contract the pride or humility of the king of Israel, Naaman, and Elisha.
- B. Read Proverbs 8:13; Psalm 10:4; 1 Corinthians 4:7. Why is pride a sin?
- C. Read Genesis 3:5; Isaiah 14:12-14. In what ways is pride the root of all sin?
- D. How might pride be at the root of each of these:
 - 1. Angry at others
 - 2. Lying about ourselves
 - 3. Being offended
 - 4. Being passive aggressive
 - 5. Dominating a conversation
- F. Read <u>2 Corinthians 10:17-18; James 4:10</u>. How can we overcome pride?

MAKING IT RELEVANT

- 1. Are you, like Naaman, blind to God's sovereign work around you?
- 2. How has God's sovereignty over the nations been revealed in our world today?
- 3. Do you see yourself in question 2D? Is there an element of pride at its root? How can you turn the pride into humility?
