BECAUSE OF YOU,

A HARVEST HAS COME FROM PAST-SOWN SEEDS

This story begins in 1923. David Ellison was the second Protestant missionary to go to Cambodia, where he served for 40 years, gave his life in 1963, and is buried. He never saw a harvest, but he faithfully brought the gospel to Cambodia.

Forty years after Ellison's death, attendees to the Cambodian national church general council visited his grave. The church president proclaimed, "We've come to this grave site to thank Jesus for sending missionaries to our land . . . and to follow this man's example to give our lives to bring the gospel to peoples who have not heard." That year, the Cambodian Alliance church sent their first missionary to Mondulkiri to translate the New Testament and plant churches among the Bunong people. As a result, the church grew. The missionaries left Mondulkiri because the church had been established.

But God continues to grow the church there today. In fact, during the COVID season, 10 churches were planted in northern Cambodia, and 7 new churches were planted in the Mondulkiri province!

Why is this story important? First, it shows the perseverance of those who go to new, hard places even when they don't get to see a lot of fruit. And second, it shows the Alliance family's commitment for the long haul to see Jesus' name taken into a land of unreached peoples. Even with all that's going on in the world today, you continue to send other "David Ellisons" because you believe God is faithful to build His Church. He is at work—even while we wait for His time for His harvest.
