

# The Work of the Holy Spirit

## Matthew 3:16-17

## Introduction

## I. Who is the Holy Spirit?

The Holy Spirit is a member of the Trinity, which is made up of three distinct persons: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

## II. Characteristics of the Holy Spirit

The biblical descriptions demonstrate the Holy Spirit has the characteristics of a personality. For example:

- A. The Holy Spirit has a mind (Rom. 8: 27)
- B. The Holy Spirit has a will (1 Cor. 12:11)
- C. The Holy Spirit has emotion (Isa. 63:10)
- D. The Holy Spirit intercedes for us (Rom. 8:16)
- E. The Holy Spirit teaches us (John 14:26)
- F. The Holy Spirit comforts us (John 14:16)
- G. He bears witness or testifies (Rom. 8:16)
- H. He guides believers into all truth and tells them about the future (John 16:13)
- I. The Holy Spirit grieves and intercedes for us (Isa. 63:10; Rom. 8:26)
- J. The Holy Spirit gives joy (Luke 10:21; 1 Thess. 1:6)
- K. He leads and can be resisted (Acts 7:51; Rom. 8:14)
- L. He strengthens and encourages (Acts 9:31; Acts 5:3)
- M. He can be quenched and blasphemed (Matt. 12: 31-32; 1 Thess. 5:19)
- N. He helps us in our Weakness (Rom. 8:26)

## III. Reasons Why God Gives the Holy Spirit to the Believers

The Holy Spirit is the agent in the new birth (John 3:5-8). He serves as the believer's identifying mark," a promise, and guarantee (Eph. 1:13-14). God gives us the Holy Spirit not only to enable us to live out a Christian life, also to prove that we are precious in His sight. The Holy Spirit works with the Father and the Son in the life of a believer to make him pleasing to God-which is his ultimate purpose for saving the believer (1 Pet. 1:2).

## IV. Why Christians Need the Holy Spirit (Gal. 5:1-26)

The manifestations of the Holy Spirit altogether are what forms the spirit-filled life.

A. The Holy Spirit helps believers conquer their sin nature. He will help us make the right decisions, if we listen to his advice

B. The Holy Spirit bears witness with our spirit that we are the children of God (Rom. 8:16)

C. The Holy Spirit will produce godly qualities in our lives when we depend on His leading. He helps develop godly qualities known as (the Fruit of the Spirit) in our lives (Gal. 5:16-26)

D. The Holy Spirit helps us follow God's guidelines by giving us the power to maintain a meaningful relationship with God. If we listen and stay focused on Jesus, we won't miss the mark

E. He encourages us to seek God's approval above mere man's praises. We will seek God's glory above our own glory when we submit completely to the Holy Spirit. He makes following Christ a joy rather than a burden

F. The Holy Spirit opens our spiritual eyes (I Cor. 2:10). The deep secret things of the Lord belong to His children and we can't know them except God reveals them to us through the Holy Spirit

Could anyone imagine what this world would be like if the restrainer of the devil, the Holy Spirit, isn't at work (2 Thess. 2:7)? To enjoy the company and manifestations of the Holy Spirit in our lives, we must endeavor to see that He is not:

-lied to (Acts 5:3-5)
-grieved (Eph. 4:30)
-extinguished (I Thess. 5:19)
-resisted (Acts 7:51)
-insulted (Heb. 10:29)
-blasphemed (Matt. 12:31-32)
```

## V. Conclusion

Do you know, you're "God's masterpiece," which means that His Spirit is working in your life to make you more like Christ and that gives you a purpose for pursuing Christ-like living? Let's go home and pick up from where we lack and ask the Spirit of the Living God to motivate us to live righteously for Him.
