



This ministry to the marginalized was forged in a difficult circumstance. When Suzanne and Kelly's daughter Aimee was hit and killed by a car on a freeway onramp, she was homeless and struggling emotionally. Suzanne says,

"Two months prior to Aimee's passing, God told me to 'feed his sheep'. Twelve days before, the Lord told me to "minister to the poor, sick and the lost." I felt led to provide a Thanksgiving dinner the night before Thanksgiving so my daughter's Suzanne, Lauren and I set up tables with food, clothing and supplies at Big Rec Park in Long Beach. The next morning, Thanksgiving Day, we learned that Aimee had been hit by a car and died. As I look back upon the situation, I can see how God had ordered my steps. God knew that I would need to be grounded and have a purpose prior to Aimee's passing. He knew that it would give me strength to deal with the pain of this tragedy. He also chose Thanksgiving Day so that when I thought of Aimee's passing, I would remember to be grateful and thankful in ALL things."

Suzanne's response after much grieving and tears was to start a ministry to meet some of the physical and emotional needs of people living in various homeless conditions.




PRAY FOR

Vincent had returned to Nigeria to research for his education and found poor children weren't educated. being Teachers wouldn't go to school, or would sign in and leave. addition, Nigeria was changing from a country inclusive of Christianity to one dominated Islam. Vincent Chinyere were broken to see what was happening to their country and people. The Lord led them to do the one thing they could, open a school that would provide low-cost education founded on the Word of God.

Beginning in 1995 with 6 children, today EWCM provides 800 children with a K-12 education founded on Jesus Christ so that they may become bearers of Good News to the nation.







In each situation, they need to hear that they are safe and loved in their new country. Pam's stories are amazing, complex and heartwarming. She has invested her heart into these people and would tell you she has grown deeply in understanding the love our heavenly Father has for his children.


