## SERMON REFLECTION

Jesus gave the Beatitudes as the framework from which all of the Sermon on the Mount can be understood. While most of the Sermon on the Mount deals with disobedience and hypocrisy, the Beatitudes show what obedience and integrity look like. Those who are persecuted for righteousness are blessed, for the kingdom of heaven is theirs.
