




Weekly Schedule



A voice cries, "In the wilderness prepare the way of the Lord; make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be lifted up, and every mountain and hill be made low; the uneven ground shall become level, and the rough places a plain. And the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together, for the mouth of the Lord has spoken." Isaiah 40:83-5

1) A God of the Strangest Things

- A) The extraordinary angelic announcement from Gabriel to Mary that she was be a mother (Luke 1:26-38) was an incredibly "strange thing" bringing both excitement and confusion!
- B) Of course, the confusion is easy to understand. Mary was
 a "pregnant engaged virgin" (1:27); a strangely scandalous
 "impossibility!" The excitement is also easy to understand. Mary
 is a (single) mother, and is going to be having a baby boy!
- C) In the midst of the announcement from Gabriel to Mary, another "impossibility" is revealed about her 'much older' 6-months pregnant formerly-barren relative Elizabeth (1:36-37)! Despite outward appearances and inward confusion, Mary is not alone!
- D) Elizabeth's pregnancy is cause for Mary to be more excited! Mary has support, even in the scandal of her pregnancy. Another miracle is at work, another new mother is not too far away! God is doing another "strange thing," but why?

2) Mary's Immediate Response to God's Message

- A) The angelic revelation of Elizabeth's pregnancy is cause for Mary to immediately depart (1:39). Mary's urgency is in obedience, knowing that Gabriel was revealing a connection between Mary & Elizabeth's pregnancies, but what is it?
- B) The trip from Mary to Elizabeth would have taken around 3-5 days, depending on conditions of the 80-100 mile trek from the Galilee area (Nazareth, cf. 1:26) to the area around Jerusalem (the hill country of Judea, cf. 1:39, is to the South of Galilee).
- C) Mary is led by angelic message to seek Zechariah & Elizabeth, but the real reason for the union between these miracles is soon revealed! As soon as Elizabeth and Mary are in proximity to one another, the Holy Spirit of God fills Elizabeth's spirit and causes her baby to leap for sheer joy (1:41).
- D) John the Baptist's fetal response of pure joy in the presence of Christ is wonderful! It is an affirmation of Spirit filled life in the wombs of both women (1:41, 44). This significantly marks a response of joy in Christ's presence, of Christ's impending birth!

3) The First Time Miracle Moms Club of Judea

- A) This is the very first outward announcement/recognition of the Messiah, Jesus Christ (1:42-44). Think of the significance! God's (Holy) Spirit is making this first announcement through an unborn child being carried by a barren woman married to a mute husband to a pregnant and unmarried virgin who carries a living blessing who Elizabeth recognizes as her "Lord" (1:43)!
- B) In the midst of this beyond-human-comprehension 'high point' of God's "stranger things," Elizabeth pours Spirit filled praise onto Mary, a young mother of miracle who is distinguished for her faithful-belief and faithful-action in (quite literally) carrying the fulfillment of God's great promises (1:45)

How would the visit to Elizabeth have helped resolve any doubts she experienced?

2. Verse 41: Upon seeing Mary, "Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit, and she exclaimed..." What is the significance of the Holy Spirit in this event?

Making It Relevant

1. God used the visit to Elizabeth to bolster Mary's faith and eliminate any doubt that He is at work in her life. Have you struggled with doubts about God's working in your life? Has He relieved the doubts, or are you still waiting for His assurance?
